Preamble

The coast represents the crossroads between the oceans, land and atmosphere, and all three contribute to the physical and ecological evolution of coastlines. Coasts are dynamic systems, with identifiable inputs and outputs of energy and material. More than half the world's human population lives at the coast, and here people often come into conflict with natural coastal processes. Recurring problems such as the impacts of coastal development and new threats such as those related to invasive species, global climate change (storms, tsunamis, rise of sea level..) and other human-induced hazards require new approaches to coastal resource management

An understanding of the interactions of the land and the sea is essential in evaluating the hazards associated with coastal zones.

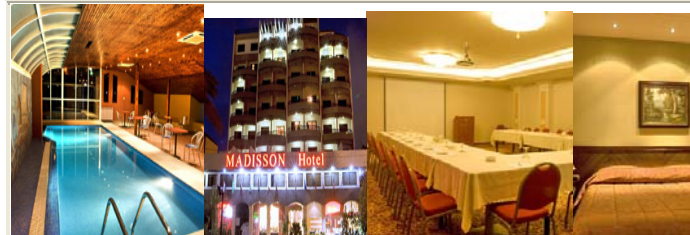
